

RESOLUTION

BUCKS COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Bucks County Bar Association has established a procedure for the review of judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County who have announced the intention of standing for election in accordance with the retention election procedures provided in the statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Rea B. Boylan, the Honorable Alan M. Rubenstein and the Honorable Susan Devlin Scott have announced their intention of standing for election in accordance with the retention election procedures provided in the statutes of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the election to be held in 2009; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Guidelines for the Merit Selection of Judges adopted by the Bucks County Bar Association a plebiscite was conducted among the members of the Bucks County Bar Association regarding the retention of the Honorable Rea B. Boylan, the Honorable Alan M. Rubenstein and the Honorable Susan Devlin Scott; and

WHEREAS, the result of such plebiscite was as follows:

Hon. Alan M. Rubenstein	291	21	20
Hon. Susan Devlin Scott	309	12	12

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Guidelines for the Merit Selection of Judges adopted by the Bucks County Bar Association, if any judge receives “endorsed” for retention votes of more than 2/3 of the members expressing an opinion in the plebiscite the Board of Directors of the Bucks County Bar Association shall issue a resolution endorsing the retention of the judge, and all of the aforementioned judges have been “endorsed” for retention by 2/3 of the members expressing an opinion.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Bucks County Bar Association:

RESOLVED, that the Honorable Rea B. Boylan, the Honorable Alan M. Rubenstein and the Honorable Susan Devlin Scott, being candidates for retention as judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, are hereby endorsed by the Bucks County Bar Association for retention as judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County.
