SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTIONS AND CRITERIA

THOMAS E. MELLON, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

The Thomas E. Mellon, Jr. Scholarship, established by the Bucks County Bar Foundation, is intended to honor one of the Bucks County Bar Association's most ardent supporters – Thomas E. Mellon, Jr.

To honor the commitment and dedication of Thomas E. Mellon, Jr., to the practice of law, to the ideals of public service and commitment to community service, we have created the Thomas E. Mellon, Jr. Scholarship Fund. Supported by individual contributions, the Thomas E. Mellon, Jr. Scholarship Fund will provide a scholarship to any candidate attending a four year liberal arts education program who has shown extraordinary commitment to public service and/or community service.

The scholarship will be provided on an annual basis and the recipients will be selected by a committee comprised of the scholarship committee and a member of the Mellon Family.

Criteria for Selection

Applicants for the Thomas E. Mellon, Jr. Scholarship must demonstrate academic excellence, financial need, Bucks County residency and the potential for making a contribution to society and/or the legal profession either through anticipated legal study or other efforts as discussed in the applicant's essay and evidenced by the applicant's recommendations or a history of extraordinary commitment to public service or community service.

AWARD: \$1000 to \$3000

The Foundation may award multiple scholarships, as deemed appropriate by the scholarship committee.

THE WILLIAM PENN SCHOLARSHIP

The Bucks County Bar Foundation recognizes that the members of the Bucks County Bar Association give tirelessly of themselves in their chosen profession as well as to their communities. The BCBF has established the William Penn Scholarship to honor and further the defining characteristics of the members of the Bucks County Bar Association, which are:

- Dedication and commitment to the legal profession;
- Wholehearted commitment to public service and community service

This Scholarship fund will provide financial assistance for post-high school education of a student interested in pursuing a career in law or a law related field who has shown extraordinary commitment to public service or community service.

Criteria for Selection

Applicants for the Award must demonstrate academic excellence, wide ranging extracurricular activities, leadership, dedicated community service and an interest in and intent to pursue a career in law or a law related field.

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must be a citizen of United States and a permanent resident of Bucks County. In addition, an applicant must be enrolled in high school as senior. The Foundation scholarship committee may consider unique factors identified on the application form in making the Award.

Award - \$1000.00

The Foundation may award multiple scholarships, as deemed appropriate by the scholarship committee.
