1. Please state your full name, address and telephone number.

2. Please state the name and address of the client with whom you have a fee dispute.

3. What was the nature of the case handled? (i.e., contract, corporate, personal injury, divorce, criminal)

4. Please state the fee charged and whether or not it has been paid.

5. Was there a written fee agreement or fee letter? If so, please attach. If not, please explain your understanding of the fee agreement.

6. What is your complaint? (i.e., fee charged was more than agreed upon, lawyer did not perform services agreed to be performed, etc.)

I verify that there is a legitimate dispute regarding the fees charged a client, as resolution of such legitimate disputes regarding fees is the sole purpose of the Bar Association's Fee Dispute process. At no time should the Fee Dispute process be used as an attempt to collect an outstanding debt.

Note: Your fee dispute will be heard by a panel of volunteer attorneys. The Fee Disputes Committee has no power to decide issues involving ethical questions. Decisions and sanctions concerning professional conduct are within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Office of the State Disciplinary Board for District II (610) 650-8210.
