

BUCKS COUNTY BAR FOUNDATION FUNDING REQUEST

Requests for funding from the Bucks County Bar Foundation for projects or events that are not already part of the Foundation's approved annual budget must be submitted initially to the Development and Finance Committee ("DFC") for review. The DFC will then make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees which ultimately decides whether to approve the expenditure. Requests for funding will be considered by the DFC twice a year. Funding requests must be submitted no later than February 1 to be considered at the DFC's April meeting, or by August 1 to be considered at the DFC's October meeting. The DFC's regularly scheduled meetings are held the second Thursday of every month and the Board of Trustees meets the first Wednesday.

In addition to completing the following form, applicants are requested to include with their application any such additional documentation that the applicant believes will provide as full and understanding and appreciation of the project for which funding is requested. The Applicant shall also be available to attend the DFC meeting at which its request is considered in order to answer any questions the DFC may have.
